The internationalisation of study and research has led to

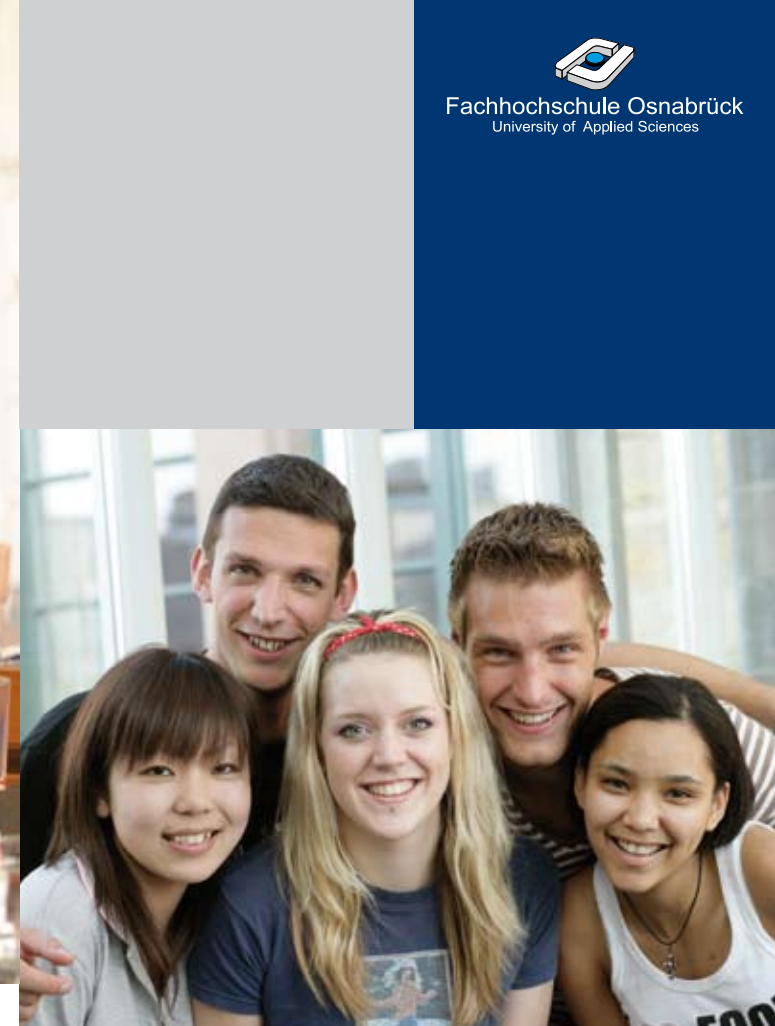
